Buy the following:

- <u>238 gram bottle of Miralax</u> (PEG-3350)
- <u>64 oz bottle of sports drink</u> such as Gatorade. If you have diabetes, buy a low calorie drink such as G2 or Crystal Light instead.
- <u>Dulcolax (bisacodyl)</u> laxative tablets

Three days before the procedure, begin a LOW RESIDUE DIET (see low residue diet instructions)

One day Before the Procedure:

- 1. Do not eat anything solid. Follow the <u>clear liquid diet</u> instructions.
- Drink only clear liquids (no red or purple dye.) Clear liquids include: water, black coffee, tea, apple juice, white grape juice, soda, Jell-O, popsicles, broth,

and Gatorade or other sport drinks.

- DO NOT drink milk or use non-dairy creamer.
- DO NOT eat or drink anything colored red or purple.
- DO NOT drink alcoholic beverages.
- 3. Clear liquids include water, black coffee, tea, apple juice, white grape juice, soda, Jell-O, popsicles, broth, and Gatorade or other sport drinks. DO NOT drink milk or use non-dairy creamer. DO NOT drink anything colored red or purple. DO NOT drink alcohol.
- 4. In a pitcher mix the 238 grams of Miralax with 64 oz of Gatorade or other sports drink. Chill.
- 5. <u>At 5 PM take 3 tablets of Dulcolax</u> laxative by mouth with water.
- 6. <u>Start to drink the Miralax at 6:00 PM</u>. Drink one glass every 15 minutes. Drink it quickly rather than sipping. Drink half of the liquid within 2 hours. Stay close to a toilet.

Day of the Procedure:

- At least 4 hours before the procedure, begin drinking the liquid again. Finish drinking it at least 2 hours before the procedure.
- Do not eat or chew gum or use tobacco. You may drink clear liquids until 2 hours before your procedure.
- Routine medications may be taken with a sip of water.

Important:

- 1. You will not be able to drive after your procedure. <u>You will need a driver</u> to stay during your procedure and to drive you home afterward.
- 2. Avoid iron supplements for 1 week before the procedure.
- 3. If you take aspirin for heart protection, DO NOT stop taking it.
- 4. If you normally take medication in the morning for high blood pressure or seizures, please take it as usual at least 2 hours before the procedure.
- 5. So that appropriate adjustments can be made, <u>please notify your doctor at least one</u> week before the procedure if you take warfarin (Coumadin), Plavix, Eliquis, Xarelto, Pradaxa, or other blood thinners.
